SOME LITURGICAL CALENDAR ITEMS

MASS FOR THE OPENING OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR

A votive *Mass of the Holy Spirit* may be scheduled for the opening of the academic year on weekdays when there is no liturgical impediment. The *Sacramentary* provides three options for this Votive Mass. One of the prefaces of the Holy Spirit is used and red vestments are worn. The *Lectionary* texts for the day are preferable.

Also, see the options in the *Book of Blessings*, Chapter 5: Order for the Blessing of Students and Teachers, for another way to liturgically celebrate the opening of the academic year.

TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Sunday, September 11, 2011

Patriot Day, September 11, is observed every year to mark the anniversary of the terrorist attacks against the United States of America. This year marks the 10th anniversary of the attacks and will be a significant occasion for prayer and reflection, especially with the celebration of Sunday Mass.

The Mass of the Sunday, with the given texts in the *Sacramentary* and *Lectionary*, is to be celebrated. The homily, with appropriate references to the Scriptures, the Prayer of the Faithful, and, perhaps, the hymn after Mass, suggest possibilities for commemorating 9/11/01.

OPTIONAL MEMORIAL OF THE HOLY NAME OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY Monday, September 12, 2011

The texts for this new Memorial in the USA may be taken from the Common of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the *Sacramentary* and the *Liturgy of the Hours*. The appendix (X, n. 5) to the *Sacramentary* provides the Collect for the Memorial. The *Collection of Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary* (n. 21) provides a Mass for the Holy Name of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

• Pastors or priest chaplains select candidates to serve for a parish or institution. Candidates are to be fully initiated practicing Catholics, high school graduates, validly married, if married, and recognized for faith and devotion to the Holy Eucharist as well as for service in the parish or institution.

• Pastors or priest chaplains are encouraged to send new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the archdiocesan formation sessions. Current Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are also welcome to attend these sessions.

• Pastors and priest chaplains are reminded to inform the Office for Divine Worship if they conduct their own formation and to send to the office their request for new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Request forms can be found on the Office for Divine Worship website. Letters of Appointment from the Archbishop will then follow.

• Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are appointed for a three year term and for the place where they are commissioned. Terms may be renewed if agreeable to both the pastor or priest chaplain and the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.

• Pastors and priest chaplains are reminded to conduct the commissioning of new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion according to the rite found in the Book of Blessings, Chapter 63.
