Points to Ponder

Points to ponder while finalizing plans for Lent and Triduum

Point One

What changes have you made to the music of your weekend Liturgies in keeping with the character of the season? If you rarely sing the Kyrie, have you added a sung Kyrie for the weeks of Lent? Have you scaled back on instrumentation and organ registrations to reduce the emphasis on the accompaniment and provide a simpler support for the sung prayers? Have you explored adding music from the rich treasury of sacred music, possibly chanting the Agnus Dei?

While we're on the subject of changing things up for Lent, did you know the Roman Missal offers the option to pray the Apostles' Creed during Lent and Easter Time because of its association with Baptism? (The Order of the Mass, "19. Instead of the Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed, especially during Lent and Easter Time, the baptismal Symbol of the Roman Church, known as the Apostles' Creed, may be used.")

Point Two

During Lent, parishes often observe practices such as Stations of the Cross, Bible Study programs, and Liturgy of the Hours. Music greatly enhances any prayer experience. As your parish gathers for these additional devotions, programs and Liturgy, is music a part of their prayer experience? Is it quality music that reflects the character of the Lenten season and supports the sung prayer of the community or an after-thought thrown together while attention is focused on the "big events" of the season?

Point Three

The following parts of the Triduum should be sung. What steps have you taken to ensure they are sung? How much time is set aside to prepare the deacon, priest or cantor to chant these parts?

- Good Friday
 - The Solemn Intercessions
 - The Chant during the Showing of the Holy Cross, as well as the specific chants identified for use during the Veneration of the Holy Cross
- Easter Vigil
 - The Acclamations during the Procession with the Paschal Candle
 - The Easter Proclamation (Exsultet)
 - After the Epistle, the three-fold Solemn Easter Alleluia followed by Psalm 118
 - The Acclamation after the Blessing of the Water, Springs of water, bless the Lord...
- Easter Sunday
 - The Easter Sequence
 - The Dismissal with alleluias

An excellent resource for further reflection would be the <u>Circular Letter Concerning the Preparation and Celebration of the Easter Feasts</u>, published by the Congregation for Divine Worship on Saturday, February 20, 1988.
