**SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST
SUNDAY, JUNE 14**

The Eucharistic Procession associated with this solemnity may occur on or near the day of its liturgical observance. The ritual plan for this procession can be found in the liturgical book, *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist outside Mass*.

**SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS
FRIDAY, JUNE 19**

This year the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus marks the beginning of the *Year for Priests* announced earlier this year by Pope Benedict XVI. Special mention of this *Year for Priests* may be included in the introductory remarks at Mass. The following petition may be included in the Prayer of the Faithful as the first of the petitions.

That the observance of this *Year for Priests* will bear much fruit with renewed holiness of life for priests and understanding of the role of the priest in the Church and society, let us pray to the Lord.

**ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEDICATION
OF THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

Pastors and chaplains are reminded to inform the Office for Worship if they are conducting their own training and to send to this office their request for new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are appointed for a three year term and for the place where they are commissioned. Terms may be renewed if agreeable to both the pastor/chaplain and the minister.
