FEAST OF THE EXULTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS Tuesday, September 14

Today, His Eminence, Cardinal Justin Rigali, celebrates his silver jubilee as a Bishop. The following petition may be included in the Prayer of the Faithful for Sunday, September 12, and today.

MASS FOR THE OPENING OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR

A votive *Mass of the Holy Spirit* may be scheduled for the opening of the academic year on the weekdays during September when there is no liturgical impediment. The *Sacramentary* provides three options for this Votive Mass. One of the prefaces of the Holy Spirit is used and red vestments are worn. The *Lectionary* texts for the day are preferable.

COMMUTATION OF THE PERIODS AND STEPS

The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* allows for a commutation and adaptation of the periods and steps for sacramental initiation which typically correspond to the observance of Lent and the celebration of the Easter Vigil. The Bishop can allow for such commutation and adaptation in exceptional circumstance. Cardinal Rigali grants such permission.

Numbers 34 and 331 in the ritual book, *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*, describe arrangements for an adapted process for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.
