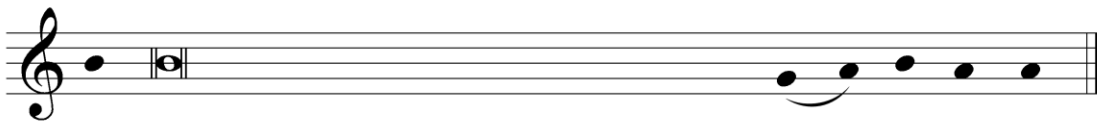
Let us pray, dearly beloved, for the people in Ukraine, and in all war zones of the world,



for those who have fled the dread of violence and have been deprived of their homes,

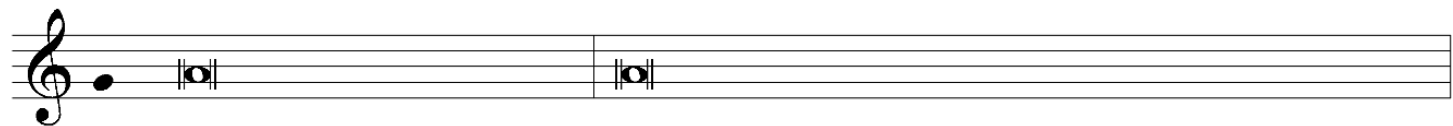


for all men and women who stand up with their lives



to ward off evil and protect the weak and the per - se - cut - ed.

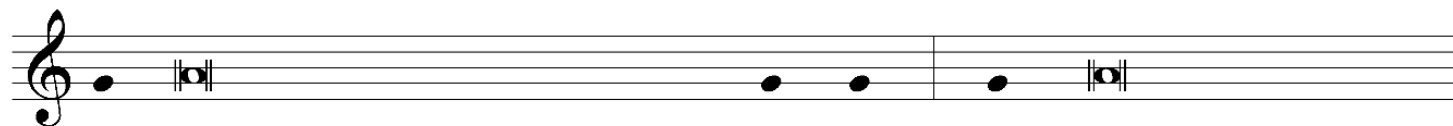
Prayer in silence. Then the Priest sings:

but you cast down op - pres - sors. As you guided Israel out of slavery in E - gypt,



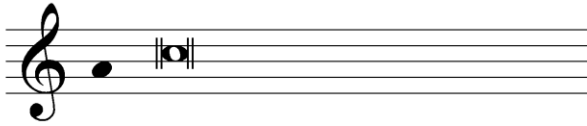
so in our days save all victims of war and vio - lence. Change the hearts of evildoers,



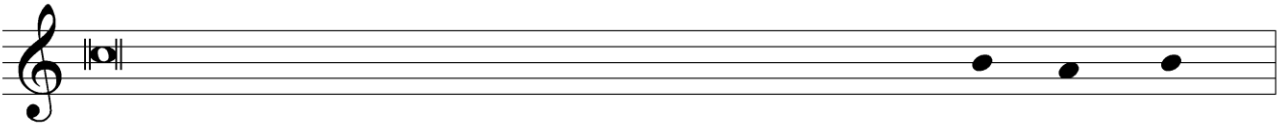

## XII. For an end to the pandemic

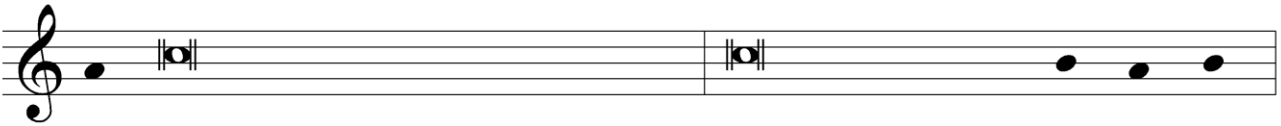

that our God and Father will heal the sick, strengthen those who care for them

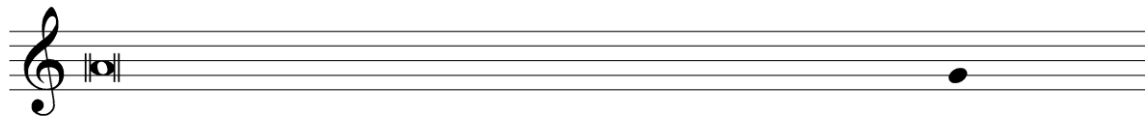
