Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for Adults 2023

Archbishop Nelson J. Perez will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on Pentecost **Sunday, May 28, 2023 at the 11:00 AM Mass**. *All priests are invited to concelebrate. Please vest with archdiocesan vestments in the Neumann Room*.

The Sacrament of Confirmation brings a baptized person to full stature in Christ and is a significant moment in a Christian's life. Preparation for this Sacrament at the parish should include catechetical instruction, an opportunity for the celebration of the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation and the selection of a sponsor.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY:

Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation:

As part of the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, pastors should make available an opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation near to the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. This same opportunity should be made available to Sponsors and family members. Please encourage everyone to receive Communion at the Confirmation Mass.

Registration:

- The registration form for the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation can be found on the website of the Office for Divine Worship under the tab for Christian Initiation.

- PLEASE REMEMBER TO SCAN ALL BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATES AND LETTER'S OF ELIGIBILITY AND EMAIL TO worship@archphila.org
- Deadline: All information must be received by Monday, May 22, 2023

- Please ensure that the name for Confirmation, if one is selected other than the Baptism name, is a canonized saint's name.
- If any of the candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation are also to receive their First Communion at this Mass, please indicate on the form.
- Please ensure that the sponsor satisfies the usual canonical requirements, as outlined on the <u>Archdiocesan Guidelines page</u>.
- Please ensure that all adult parish candidates are included in this registration process.

If for some serious reason, a school age baptized Roman Catholic is unable to be confirmed by the Bishop during his pastoral visit to the parish, then this candidate, with the permission of the pastor, may be presented for the Sacrament of Confirmation on Pentecost Sunday. The pastor's permission is to be included with the registration to be sent to the Office for Divine Worship.

- Reserved seating is assigned for candidates and sponsors only. Seating of candidates and sponsors by the ushers will be as they arrive. Ushers will be instructed to fill in the pews, therefore, it is possible that people from the same parish may not be seated together.
- An email confirming receipt of registrations will be sent to the email on the registration form.
- The <u>Confirmation Name Card template</u> is available on the Christian Initiation page of the Office for Divine Worship website.
- Please be sure the candidate for Confirmation arrives at the Cathedral with the Name Card in hand and filled out – <u>front and back</u>. THE CONFIRMATION NAME ONLY IS TO BE PRINTED IN <u>LARGE</u> LETTERS ON THE FRONT OF CARD.
- This card is collected as the candidate approaches the Archbishop for Confirmation.
- After the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation, the information on the card will be recorded at the Cathedral Basilica and a notification is to be sent by the parish or institution to the church of Baptism. Commemorative certificates will

not be issued.

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS TO BE SHARED WITH ALL THE CANDIDATES FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION:

Parking: Limited parking is available in the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center lot.

Time: Plan to arrive at the Cathedral by 10:00 AM. Ushers will direct you

to your seats. Catechesis/Instruction on the celebration of the

Sacrament of Confirmation will begin at 10:30 AM.

Dress: Coat and tie for men, dress clothing for women. No Confirmation

robes or stoles are to be worn.

Candidate Seating: Candidates will be directed as they arrive to be seated in the pews

reserved and marked for the candidates.

Sponsor Seating: Sponsors will be directed to sit in the pews reserved and marked for

the sponsors directly behind their candidates.

Guest Seating: Unreserved seats are available for family and guests. Please inform

guests that pictures and videos may be taken only from their seats

during Mass.

Special Seating: If your parish has a Confirmation Candidate or Sponsor who will

need special seating because of a disability, please indicate this on the registration form. Someone from the Office for Divine Worship

will contact you regarding seating.

REMEMBER TO BRING TO THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA:

Confirmation Name Card with the Candidate's Confirmation name.

- Please print on the front of the Name Card:
 - the Confirmation Name IN BIG LETTERS
- Please print on the reverse side of the Name Card:
 - the Candidate's name and parish, and
 - the Sponsor's full name.
- These cards will be collected and serve as a record that a Candidate has been confirmed.
